Note 1.

Denbighshire Intermediate and Technical Education Fund was "given under the official seal of the Minister of Education this 23rd day of May, 1949". The Scheme specifically excluded the Hospital of Sir John Wynne of Gwydyr.

The 1949 Scheme referred to Land and buildings occupied as almishouses. The Scheme referred to annual payment out of the endowments of the Foundation applicable for educational purposes £249. This is the amount paid against Reference 008. Scheme sealed 5th July, 1957, relating to sale of land.

Denbighshire Further Education Trust Fund was the name used on an application in Johnship registration as a charity in relation to the Scheme established by Minister of Education 23rd May, 1949. Letter dated 15th February, 1982, from Charity Commission confirming registration of Denbighshire Further Education Trust Fund with Registration Number 512280.

Schools under the Denbighshire Intermediate and Technical Education Scheme ceased to exist as from 1944 (Education Act, 1944). Trust Fund 413 appears to only relate to the sale of land at Denbigh Middle Lane in 1988 and 1989. This is therefore, part of the overall Denbighshire Further Education Trust Fund.

Denbighshire Further Education Trust Fund, from a document dated July 1992, included Trust Fund 413 which transferred to Denbighshire County Council in 1996. It also included the following Accounts which were transferred \* Endowment Account - Wiresham Grammar School - Sude of Land; Endowment Account Rusbon Grammar School.

Note 2.

The sums of cash for awards have accumulated since 1996 and include the balances transferred from Clwyd County Council.

Note 3.

The sums of repaid investments held as cash have arisen as Government Securities have matured and been repaid. No reinvestment has taken place for matured investments listed but amounts held are to be reinvested.

Note 4.

If the current capital value of a Trust Fund is less than the original value this is likely to be because the value of the investment was lower on redemption. This should have been offset by the interest payments earned over the life of the investment.
