Gweithgareddau Aelod Lleol

Yn ystod y flwyddyn cyngor diwethaf, rwyf wedi cynorthwyo llawer o breswylwyr o fewn fy ward ac wedi cyfeirio eraill naill ai at gynghorydd neu adran briodol y cyngor. Mae hyn wedi amrywio o faterion parcio, lleithder difrifol o fewn tai cyngor, i gymdogion oedd yn achosi problemau a phryderon cynllunio. Yn ddiweddar rwyf wedi cael llawer o gwynion ynghylch torri glaswellt, roedd hyn oherwydd rhai problemau cychwynnol gyda contractwr tirwedd newydd, ond mae'n ymddangos bod yr holl bryderon wedi cael eu datrys erbyn hyn. Byddaf yn parhau i fod wrth law, pryd bynnag y bo modd, i holl drigolion Henllan a Dinbych Uchaf, er mwyn ymdrin â'u holl bryderon a materion a gyfyd.

Prosiectau Mawr

Yn dilyn cais llwyddiannus Cyngor Sir Ddinbych i gael £1.1 miliwn o gyllid gan Lywodraeth Cymru er mwyn cyflwyno prosiect effeithlonrwydd ynni yn ardal Dinbych Uchaf a Henllan. Mae'r prosiect yn bennaf i inswleiddio waliau allanol 108 eiddo yn Ninbych Uchaf. Bydd y rhain ar Ffordd y Ffair (gyferbyn Caledfryn), Lôn Llewelyn, Myddleton Avenue a Maes Glas Avenue. Dewiswyd y tai ar feini prawf ystadegol ac hefyd oherwydd eu waliau solet neu eu waliau ceudod cul; gan wneud inswleiddio waliau ceudod yn amhriodol.

Fel y cynghorydd sy'n monitro hamdden, sy'n rhan o fy rôl craffu perfformiad, rwyf yn falch iawn bod ein hawdurdod yn enghraifft brin o un sydd wedi parhau i fuddsoddi a datblygu ein cyfleusterau hamdden ledled y sir. Yn lleol mae uwchraddio'r wyneb maes chwarae pob tywydd 4G yng nghanolfan hamdden, Dinbych, yn profi'n boblogaidd iawn gyda chlybiau lleol, yn ogystal â'r estyniad arfaethedig i'r ystafell hamdden, a fydd bron yn ei dyblu o ran maint.

Dear Resident

The purpose of this report is to keep you informed of some of the meetings / issues I have dealt with on your behalf and as a member of Denbighshire County Council during the 2014/15 municipal (Council) year which ran from May 2014 to May 2015.

Local Member Activities

In this last municipal year, I have assisted many residents within my ward and guided others to either the appropriate councillor or council dept. This has varied and ranged from parking issues, severe damp within council houses to problem neighbours and planning concerns. Recently I've had many complaints regarding grass cutting, this was due to some early teething problems with a new landscape contractor, all concerns now seem to have been resolved. I will continue to be on hand, whenever possible, for all residents of Henllan and upper Denbigh, dealing with all their concerns and issues.

Major Projects

Following Denbighshire County Council's successful bid to get £1.1 million of Welsh Government funding so as to deliver an energy efficiency project in Upper Denbigh and the Henllan area. The project is primarily to install external wall insulation (EWI) to 108 properties in Upper Denbigh. These will be on Smithfield Road (opposite Caledfryn), Lôn Llewelyn, Myddleton Avenue and Maes Glas Avenue. The houses were selected based upon statistical criteria and also due to their solid wall or narrow cavity wall construction; making cavity wall insulation inappropriate.

As the councillor who monitors leisure, as part of my performance scrutiny role, I am really pleased in how our authority is a rarity, in that we continue to invest and develop our leisure facilities throughout the county. Locally the upgrade to a 4G surface to the Denbigh leisure centre all weather pitch is proving very popular with local clubs as is the pending extension to the leisure suite, which will almost double it in size.
