Local Member Activities

Working with ward residents across the South East Ward of Rhyll to try to fulfil their wishes to make the South East a better place to live.

Working with other Town and County Councillors towards the regeneration of Rhyll.

Major Projects

Over my past 15 years as South East Ward Councillor I have been working with Denbighshire Highways and Traffic Department to make our roads a safer place for our children, Work including 20mph speed signs on Grange Road outside Rhyll High, work outside the Shops on Trellewelyn Road and turn around inside Ysgol Llewelyn will also be complemented with 20mph.

Highway safety work on Pen y Maes Avenue is due to start soon.

Rhodfa Maen Gwyn to Aberkinsey will only be open to pedestrians and will not be open to vehicular traffic.

Work at Llys Brenig, Park View Play Area and Nature Reserve is taking shape.
