

Order Made Under Section 91(1) Local Government Act 1972
Bodelwyddan Town Council (Temporary Appointment of Member) Order 2017

THIS ORDER is made on the 23rd day of May 2017 by Denbighshire County Council (“the County Council”).

1. WHEREAS following the recent decision of a person elected to Bodelwyddan Town Council (“the Town Council”) not to take up the office of Councillor, one Councillor is needed to give a minimum number required for a quorum.
2. Under Section 91 Local Government Act 1972, where there are so many vacancies in the office of Town Councillor that the Town Council is no longer able to act, the County Council may, by order, appoint a person or persons to fill all or any of the vacancies until other Councillors are co-opted or elected to take office.

NOW in pursuance of the Power conferred upon it by Section 91(1) Local Government Act 1972, the County Council hereby appoints the following person to act as a Member of Bodelwyddan Town Council until an election has been held or new Councillors have been co-opted to fill such vacancies as shall constitute and re-establish a quorum on the Parish Council whereupon such appointment and this Order shall cease:

- **Councillor Richard Mainon** (Councillor for Bodelwyddan Ward)
