

# **Conwy and Denbighshire Public Services Board – Environmental Policy Statement**

#### Introduction

Environment resilience is a priority area of the Conwy and Denbighshire Public Services Board (PSB) as outlined in their <u>Local Well-being Plan</u> for the region. This priority considers several aspects of environmental resilience, including - the need to better prepare for the impacts of climate change and to work together to prevent climate change, (such as reducing our carbon and ecological footprints).
