Denibighishire Further Education Trust Fund was the name used on an application in January 1982 for registration as a charity in relation to the Scheme established by Minister of Education 23rd May, 1949. Letter dated 15th February, 1982, from Charity Commission confirming registration of Denibighahire Further Education Trust Fund with Registration Number 512280.

Schools under the Denibighahire Intermediate and Technical Education Scheme esseate to exist as from 1944 (Education Act, 1944).

Trust Fund 413 appears to only relate to the sale of land at Denibighahire Further Education Trust Fund.

Note 2.

The sums of cash for awards have accumulated since 1996 and include the balances transferred from Clwyd County Council.

Note 3.

The sums of repaid investments held as cash have arisen as Government Securities have matured and been repaid. No reinvestment has taken place for matured investments listed but amounts held are to be reinvested.

Note 4.

If the current capital value of a Trust Fund is less than the original value this is likely to be because the value of the investment was lower on redemption. This should have been offset by the interest payments earned over the life of the investment.
