

Notice of Motion put forward by Councillor Hugh Irving, on behalf of the Welsh Conservatives Group for consideration by Full Council.

'There is concern within the Prestatyn Community that one of the larger towns in North Wales remains many years after the Divisional Police HQ and local facilities were relocated to the St Asaph Business Park, with no Police Facilities in the town.

Every rateable property in Prestatyn contributes at least £330 to finance the Police Service. With many new residential developments under way this sum will rise substantially but with increased population comes demand and there are already anti-social behaviour issues requiring frequent intervention.

The group recognise there is little headroom in the North Wales Police Capital programme to build new facilities but there is an opportunity for Denbighshire County Council to provide North Wales Police with premises suitable for a local Police Station within a Town Centre Project nearing completion.

It is proposed that the Council pass a resolution asking the Authority to intensify their discussions regarding these premises with North Wales Police and take all action in their power to negotiate terms that will meet this objective.'
