

NOTICE OF MOTION PUT FORWARD BY COUNCILLOR BRIAN JOMES ON BEHALF OF THE CONSERVATIVE GROUP FOR CONSIDERATION BY FULL COUNCIL.

INTRODUCTION:

The Alex Angels are a small group of retired medical professionals who trained at the Royal Alexander Hospital (RAH) Rhyl in their youth before embarking on successful medical careers within various health authorities and in particular the North Wales area. The Alex Angels understand the current issues of Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board (BCUHB) and more importantly have the common sense knowhow on what could be done to fix many of current problems BCUHB are experiencing.

Early indications are that staffing and financial requirements to meet the petition objectives are accessible from current BCUHB budgets and internal and external recruitment avenues.

Denbighshire County Council could also support the financial aspects of the petition from their emergency fund reserves.

THE NOTICE OF MOTION:

'1)The motion calls on all Denbighshire County Councillors to pledge their support to the current on-line and hard copy Royal Alexander Angels petition that calls on BCUHB to carry out a feasibility study to reinstate bed capacity at the RAH, Rhyl on a short to medium basis with a view to relieving the current bed blocking capacity within some areas of the region.

2)The motion also calls on the relevant Denbighshire County Council (DCC) Officers, the relevant DCC Lead Cabinet Member and the newly appointed BCUHB to engage and meet with the Alex Angels group in meaningful collaboration and discussions following the proposed feasibility study outcome.

3)The motion also calls on the DCC Community Scrutiny Committee to include an item agenda on their forward work programme to receive from DCC Officers a BCUHB feasibility study report on the Alex Angels petition along with a detailed brief on the proposed collaboration and discussions referred to above between the named stakeholders.'
