Prestatyn

Phase 3 is now well underway with no issues. Piling operations have almost been completed and the import and compaction of fill material to the finished profile has commenced. Final topsoiling and seeding will follow on in the Spring with the whole works expected to be completed well ahead of the original programmed date.

Rhyl

Work continues to progress well with very few delays caused by adverse weather. Placement of the rear wall units is ongoing as is the construction of the main access ramp. Demolition of the SeaQuarium was delayed but commenced on 6th January 2025. Works overall remain around one month ahead of programme.
