What's happening?

We are from Denbighshire County Council and our job is to make schools better.

We came to St Brigid's and Blessed Edward Jones earlier this year to talk to parents and to the school council.

We have a plan to improve the two schools and want to tell you about it.



What is the plan?

We would like Blessed Edward Jones and St Brigid's to become one school.

At first not very much would change. There would be one school but it would be in two places.

One part would be where St Brigid's is now and the other would be where Blessed Edward Jones is now.

It would probably be like this for the next 5 years.



What will change?

The new school would have a different name, you may have a different uniform to wear and there would be only one headteacher in charge of both parts of the new school.

The teachers and children at St Brigid's and Blessed Edward Jones would become part of the same school.

After about 3 years we will come back and ask you if you want us to make a new school building. This would be bigger so it could fit everybody in one place. We are thinking about this now and looking for the right place to build it.

Why are we asking you?

We want to ask you what you think about our plan. We will come to see your school council again, like we did before, and listen to what you have to say.



Why do we think things need to change?

The two schools are already good, but they could be even better. We think a new school will be a much better place to learn.

We don't want things to change too quickly and that's why we would like the two schools to join together at first without the pupils having to move. If that works then we can think about making a brand new school building and bringing everyone together. A new building will have better places to do **PE, computers and art.**

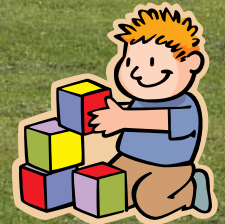
