

This required lifting the panels above waist height. All lifting/removing of panels needed to be a 2 man lift for which I (GF) assisted with. At the time of the lift there was comment or mention of any injury having occurred. How ever the next morning of the 11th of May Mr Hughes attended work and was describing some discomfort he had in his shoulder the previous evening and that morning. The next day the 12th BH had phoned in sick due to the pain in his shoulder.
