Following further consideration of the Planning Committee Report, Public Protection Officers have requested a further condition to require the submission of a Construction Management Plan prior to any construction works commencing on site.

Officer Note – Officers consider that the additional condition for a Construction Method Statement (as requested by the Public Protection Officer) is reasonable and should be added.

Suggested additional condition:

The following additional condition is therefore proposed to be inserted as Condition 21:

21 No site clearance or construction works shall be permitted to commence until the written approval of the Local Planning Authority has been obtained to a detailed Construction Method Statement. The Statement shall provide details of, but not be limited to, the following details; a) the arrangements for the parking of vehicles of site operatives and visitors;

b) the hours of site works and deliveries;

c) pollution prevention and control measures, including measures to control the emission of dust and dirt, and to prevent pollution of watercourses;

d) measures to minimise noise and disturbance to neighbouring residential properties / properties in the vicinity of the site; and,

e) Details of the source of water to be used for construction activities.

Reason 21 In the interests of protecting public and residential amenity, pollution prevention and control, and of the safety and the free flow of traffic on the adjoining highway.

The Officers present were Sarah Stubbs (Development Management).

The reason for calling the site panel was to allow opportunity to view the character of the surrounding area and how the site relates to the surrounding area (including dwellings) and AONB.

At the Site Inspection panel meeting, Members considered the following matters:

- 1. The character and use of the site and details of the proposal.
- 2. The planning history of the site, in particular the application withdrawn in 2023.
- 3. The site in relation to the nearby residential properties and boundary of the AONB.

In relation to the matters outlined:

- 1. The Officer outlined the proposals which include the change of use of land for a mixed use of residential, agricultural (existing smallholding) and arboricultural uses and the associated development including the storage building. Members observed the site features, storage building and boundaries and the access works which have been undertaken.
- 2. The Officer outlined the nature of the previous planning application, which included a Class B2 timber storage and processing facility and how this proposal differs from the previously withdrawn scheme. Members asked about the use of the building on site.
- 3. Members observed the location of residential properties at a higher level on Rhuallt Road and also observed the landscaping/site boundaries.

Amended/additional conditions:

Amendment suggested to Condition 4: -

4. The steel framed building shall only be used for the storage of machinery/equipment in connection with the approved mixed use of the site for residential, agricultural in connection with the existing smallholding and arboricultural uses (for Arbworks Uk Ltd only).

Reason: To ensure the appropriate use of the building in the open countryside and to protect the amenity of the site and surroundings.

Amendment suggested to condition 10:

10. Should the use of the Arboricultural business (Arbworks UK Ltd) cease or move to a different site, the steel framed storage building shall be removed and the site restored in accordance with details to be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The details for the site restoration shall be submitted to the Local Planning Authority within 6 months of the use ceasing and shall include details of the timing of site restoration. Only those details as approved shall be implemented thereafter.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity and the amenity of the area
